Reactive Monitoring Mission in Laponia

The Laponia World Heritage site was raised during the Committee meeting in New Delhi due to planned mining activities in Kallak.

At the Committee meeting in Riyadh in 2023, a decision was made to visit to the site Laponia by Unesco together with the expert bodies Icomos and IUCN. The visit was carried out in May 2024, under the direction of the Swedish National Heritage Agency in close cooperation with the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency and Laponia.

The World Heritage Committee now urge the Sweden not to make any further decisions on the matter before the report from the Unesco visit to Laponia is presented at the next committee meeting in 2025.
