
- In 2023 World Heritage has established an official and regular exchange with the state offices

Education


- We are currently working with a school publisher to create a national learning resource on heritage in Switzerland
- This will serve as the basis. The local heritage sites can link their teaching materials to it
- To better integrate the world heritage into everyday school life
 - we are present at the largest education fair
 - we communicate jointly with the school publishing house
 - we enter into new co-operations with other educational institutions



New Project



- Apart from our membership fee, we only receive money from the authorities for projects
- So we are in the process of launching a new project for 4 years
 - "From consuming to earning a destination using the example of World Heritage Sites"
 - Along the customer journey, guests are to be informed about the values of the World Heritage site using the latest technology
 - This makes travelling more sustainable and compatible for the World Heritage Site and the local population
 - Certain groups (e.g. students) can 'earn' access to visitor centers or guided tours with questionnaires, quizzes or voluntary work
 - The project should contribute to sustainable and compatible tourism and have a positive influence on visitor guidance and behaviour
